Review (A Pestalozzi Approach)

Instructions to participants:

Version 1:

The participants stand in a circle with a soft ball.

The participant with the ball names a participant and throws the ball to that participant who has to say something about Pestalozzi (a word or a sentence depending on the level of the students).

Any participant who fails to say something or who repeats something already said by another participant is out.

Participants should throw randomly but ensure all are included.

Version 2:

The game is played in the same way with the participant who has the ball saying the name of a fellow participant, asking a question about Pestalozzi and throwing the ball to that participant, who then has to answer the question.

Materials Needed

- Newspaper (20 sheets), string or sellotape and two pairs of scissors
- Two marker pens
- Two cassettes or CDs of music and two music playing systems
- Two bags of sweets
