



Freeze Frame

Intermediate (Classes 7-10)

Foundation House / Elementary (Classes 5-7)



The Life of Johann Heinrich Pestalozzi (Pestalozzi Approach)

The participants do role-plays as described in the 'Role-Play' Teaching Idea.

The facilitator asks the participants in a group to freeze at any time. When asked to freeze the participants should maintain the exact positions they are in.

The facilitator then asks a participants to answer the following questions in role:

Who are you?

What is happening?

How are you feeling at this moment?

Materials Needed

Any props
and costumes
available

The participants continue their role-play while the facilitator does the same with other groups. Later the facilitator returns to the same group and asks the same questions to a different participants.

The participants re-form into groups according to what character they role-played, for example all the participants who role-played Pestalozzi go into one group.

The new groups explore their reactions to the questions given above, comparing their reactions and listing them. They also note anything else they may wish to add which is not covered by answering these three questions.

Each group chooses a spokesperson. The spokesperson presents the group's responses to the questions to the rest of the participants.
